As you will have heard in the news, school holidays in Victoria begin tomorrow, Tuesday 24 March. No decision has yet been made about whether schools will be open in Term 2.

At Catholic Regional College, St Albans we are committed to providing for the ongoing learning of all students. Should there be a closure of schools, our teachers and other relevant staff will be using online platforms to deliver programs and support students in their learning.

The tables below provide information about our online learning platforms as well as the process to be followed for accessing learning resources and completing set work. Students will be expected to follow their daily timetable and connect to their teacher and peers through the Google Classroom.

Clear responsibilities and routines for students have been set out to ensure that there is structure to their day and that learning is not disrupted. Advice for parents has also been provided to support students with *learning from home*.

We encourage ongoing communication via email to enable us to maintain a strong connection between the family and school and support the social, emotional and intellectual development of our students.

Online learning will begin from **Wednesday 15 April, if schools are closed.** We will update families through the College website as we learn more and further decisions are made. At this very confusing and concerning time, I wish all families well and urge you to do all that you can to remain healthy and safe. These holidays will be challenging for all of us, as we adjust to new realities and a different rhythm to our lives. We hold you all in our thoughts and prayers.

- Dedicate appropriate time to homework and study each evening/guided by your teacher/s.
