Dear Parents, Carers and Guardians,

Fee Relief

This is the reason that we have always kept tuition fees as low as possible.

Camps, Sports and Excursions Levy

As camps, sport and excursions will not run this year, these levies will be deducted from the 2020 fees. For families who have already paid the College fees in full, the amount paid will be credited to next year's fees for students in Year 7, 8 and 9. However, if you prefer a refund, please contact the finance team to arrange this.

We will contact all Year 10 families who have paid in full to see what they would like to do with the credit. It can be refunded, go towards fees at CRC Sydenham or cover the cost of purchasing the student laptop.

New accounts will be sent to families in the next few weeks to reflect the deduction of these levies.

Please note:

The deduction of this levy does not apply to families who received fee relief from the beginning of the year, before COVID-19. These costs are already deducted in these payment plans.
