As you will be aware, this afternoon, the Government announced a snap lockdown for Victoria, starting at 8.00pm tonight. This means that we will again revert to online learning from tomorrow morning.

- Students whose parents / carers are authorised workers.
- Students who are vulnerable and cannot work from home.
- Students with disabilities who choose to attend onsite.

If your son / daughter needs to attend school for onsite supervision, please let us know so that we have adequate staffing in place.
