Fee Reductions

The College offers two types of fee deduction:

1. **Family Discount**

Two children at CRC:	10% discount per child.	\$1,896 per child
Three children at CRC:	20% discount per child	\$1,686 per child
Four children at CRC:	30% discount per child.	\$1,475 per child

Please Note:

The deduction is on school fees only. The costs for camps, sport, excursions and the 1:1 laptop program are charged per child.

2. **Early Payment Discount**

A further \$100 discount is given to families who pay the full fees for the year by the end of Term 2.

Payment of Fees and Levies

A range of options for payment are available to parents, including up-front payment, weekly, fortnightly, monthly or by term.

To assist families in developing a payment plan we offer many different payment methods, including: cash, credit card, cheque, direct debit, Centrepay and internet banking.

Fee Concessions
