## **UNIFORM: SUMMER**

### **Physical Education Uniform**

- College navy blue polo shirt.
- Girls: College sport skirt, shorts or tracksuit pants.
  - Boys: College sport shorts or tracksuit pants.
- Sports socks (white).
- School rugby top (optional).
- College navy blue cap or bucket hat.

#### **SUMMER UNIFORM REGULATIONS**

Students are expected to have two outfits, a formal or regular uniform and the PE uniform.

- All uniform items must be purchased from Academy Uniforms.
- Summer uniform is worn in Term 1 and from Cup Day in Term 4. (Either Winter Uniform or Summer Uniform can be worn in Term 4 until Cup Day)
- In summer boys wear a short-sleeved shirt and no tie.
- In summer, students have the option of wearing the blazer.
  - At school, blazers are stored in lockers.
- In coming to and from school the jumper can only be worn under the blazer.
- The length of the summer dress must be at least on the knee.
- Undergarments should not be visible.
- If a hat is worn, only those supplied by Academy uniforms are permitted.
- The College school bag is compulsory.
- Students can only wear PE uniform for the full day if they have PE at Years 7 9, and Active Body & Fitness or Ball Sports & Coaching at Year 10.

#### SUMMER PHYSICAL EDUCATION UNIFORM

- Students may wear their <u>full</u> PE uniform to and from school on days when they have PE as a core subject. At Year 10, this will include the PE electives, Active Body & Fitness or Ball Sports & Coaching and on Interschool and Inter-house sports days.
- For Outdoor Ed (Year 10) and Drama (Year 10), students must wear their school uniform to and from school but can change for the class.
- DP (Pastoral Care) needs to be consulted re: requests for wearing PE uniform for other extraordinary
- activities (i.e. excursions).
- In Terms 1 and 4 the rugby top is optional.
- The only acceptable headwear is a navy blue cap or bucket hat (supplied by Academy).
   Students who don't have their full PE uniform must come to school in the regular uniform and change
- for PE.
- Year 7 and 8 students must wear the College bucket hat to PE during Terms 1 and 4.
   Items of the formal uniform and PE uniform cannot be mixed.

#### WINTER UNIFORM REGULATIONS

Students are expected to have two outfits, a formal or regular uniform and the PE uniform.

- All uniform items must be purchased from Academy Uniforms.
- Winter uniform is worn in Terms 2 and 3 (Either Winter Uniform or Summer Uniform can be worn in
- Term 4 until Cup Day).
- Long sleeved shirts and the ties are compulsory for boys and girls.
- The blazer **must** be worn to and from school (including to homeroom)
- In coming to and from school the jumper can only be worn **under** the blazer.
- After homeroom blazers can be stored in lockers.
- The length of the girls' kilt must be at least on the knee.
- Undergarments should not be visible.
- Shirts must have the top button done up and be tucked in.
- Ties must be done up to the collar.
  - Only hats supplied by Academy uniforms are permitted.
  - The College school bag is compulsory.

#### WINTER PHYSICAL EDUCATION UNIFORM

- Students may wear their <u>full</u> PE uniform to and from school on days when they have PE in Years 7 9
  and the PE electives at Year 10 (Active Body & Fitness or Ball Sports and Coaching) and on Interschool
  and Interhouse sports days.
- For Outdoor Ed (Year 10) and Drama (Year 10), students must wear their school uniform to and from school but can change for the class.
- DP (Pastoral Care) needs to be consulted re: requests for wearing PE uniform for other extraordinary activities (i.e., excursions)
- The rugby top is compulsory in Terms 2 and 3.
- The only acceptable headwear is a navy blue cap or bucket hat (supplied by Academy)
- Students who don't have their full PE uniform must come to school in the regular uniform and change for PF.
- Items of the formal uniform and PE uniform cannot be mixed.

# **APPEARANCE**

- Coloured nail polish and make-up are not to be worn.
- Students may wear jewellery such as watches, earrings (ears only), a ring that has significance and small religious symbols such as a crucifix.
- Apart from earrings students cannot wear any type of facial or body jewellery that requires piercing.
- Extremes of fashion, as decided by the College administration, are not acceptable.
